- Access a community of mentors from across Nigeria and globally.
- Derive personal fulfillment from supporting a colleague to grow their career and support livestock development.

Accommodation and travel costs will be provided to cover your attendance at the training workshop. You will also be provided with a small allowance to cover the costs of network connectivity for mentoring calls. Kindly note that this is an unpaid, voluntary role.

Six hours online learning course starting February 2025.

Two day face-to-face workshop with training on mentorship skills and first meetings with your mentees.

Monthly meetings with your mentee (online, or face-to-face if feasible).

Receive regular support from the training team and a network of fellow mentors as the course progresses and you develop your mentoring skills.

This course is tailored to address the unique needs of women VPPs, while inspiring all of our trainees to support women livestock farmers effectively.

We are seeking dedicated role models to inspire, empower, and guide our VPPs, helping them make a meaningful impact in their communities.
